
Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42-1/2" wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fold the panel to meet the selvage edges and from left to right cut:

- one strip 3" x 42-1/2"
- one strip 4-1/2" x 42-1/2"
- one strip 7" x 42-1/2"
- one strip 4-1/2" x 42-1/2"
- one strip 3" x 42-1/2"



From Fabric B, cut:

- eight strips 1-1/2" x 42-1/2". Subcut:
 - six strips 1-1/2" x 42-1/2"
 - two strips 1-1/2" x 26"
- one strip 3" x WOF. Subcut:
 - four squares 3" x 3"

From Fabric C, cut:

- two strips 4-1/2" x WOF, trim to 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" for top and bottom borders
- three strips 4-3/4" x WOF. Sew together end-to-end and cut two strips 4-3/4" x 44-1/2" for the side borders.

From binding, cut:

- five strips 2-1/2" x WOF

Step 1 Place a Fabric B 3" square on the top and bottom corners of the first Fabric A 3" x 42-1/2" strip. (fig. 1)

Step 2 At the top of the strip, sew a seam from the bottom left corner to the top right corner of the Fabric B square. Trim 1/4" away from the seam and flip the Fabric B square up.

Step 3 At the bottom of the strip, sew a seam from the top left corner to the bottom right corner of the Fabric B square. Trim 1/4" away from the seam and flip the Fabric B square down.

Step 4 Repeat Steps 1-3 using the last Fabric A 3" x 42-1/2" strip, sewing the seams of the Fabric B squares in the opposite direction, following fig. 2.

Step 5 Keeping your Fabric A strips in the order they were cut, sew a Fabric B 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strip to the right side of each strip.

Step 6 Sew the last Fabric B 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strip to the left side of the first Fabric A 3" x 42-1/2" strip.

Step 7 Sew the columns together, keeping them in the same order the panel was originally cut. (fig. 3)

Step 8 Sew a Fabric B 1-1/2" x 26" strip to the top and bottom of the joined columns.

Step 9 Sew a Fabric C 4-3/4" x 44-1/2" strip to either side of the quilt.

Step 10 Sew a Fabric C 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Your quilt top is now complete!
Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
