Triptych



2 Small: 15 1/4" x 25 1/4"



Large: 23" x 49 1/2"



Banner/Runner: 33" x 18"



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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Triptych:

Refer to thumbnails on pattern cover for Fabrics A-G used in this design.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels may have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 3 panels to approximately 13-1/2" x 23-1/2"

Fabric B - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 5-1/2" square. Cut remaining strip lengthwise into (2) 2" x 20-1/2" borders

Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (1) 2" x 23-1/2" border

Fabric C - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (4) 3-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles] and (4) 3" squares
Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 24" and (1) 2-1/2" x 18" borders
Cut (2) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/4" x 24" and (2) 1-1/4" x 14-3/4" borders

Fabric D - Cut (1) 5-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 5-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles

Fabric E - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 6-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice for 8 triangles] and (8) 3-3/8" squares [then cut 4 in half diagonally in 1 direction 4 in the opposite direction for 16 triangles]
Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (8) 3" squares
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 25" and (1) 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" borders

Fabric F - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 6-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice for 8 triangles] and (8) 3-3/8" squares [then cut 4 in half diagonally in 1 direction and 4 in the opposite direction for 16 triangles]


Fabric G - Cut (5) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 27", (2) 2" x 24-3/4", (1) 2" x 23-1/2", (2) 2" x 16-1/4" borders

2. Piecing Order for Triptych:

1. Stitch 2 **Fabric F** 3-3/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric E** 6-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 4 each Units 1a and 1b (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished).



2. Arrange 2 each Units 1a (U1a) and 1b (U1b), a **Fabric B** 5-1/2" square, and 4 **Fabric E** 3" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Center Star (10-1/2" square unfinished). Center Star - Make 1



3. Sew **Fabrics C** and **E** 3-3/8" triangles together along long edges as shown. Make a total of 4 each Units 2a and 2b (3" square unfinished).




4. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics C** and **E** 3" squares and 2 Unit 2a (U2a) in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 Unit 3a (5-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 Unit 3b with 2 Unit 2b (U2b) and 1 each **Fabrics C** and **E** 3" squares.



5. Sew a **Fabric F** 6-1/4" triangle to bottom of a Unit 1a (U1a). Add **Fabric E** 3-3/8" triangles as shown. Make a total of 2 Unit 4a (11-1/4" x 8" x 8" unfinished). In the same manner, make a total of 2 Unit 4b with Unit 1b (U1b) in place of Unit 1a.




6. Stitch long edges of **Fabric D** 5-7/8" triangles to each Units 4a (U4a) and 4b (U4b) as shown to make 2 each Units 5a and 5b (5-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).



Not all cut triangles are used

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7. Arrange Center Star, Units 3a, 3b, 5a, and 5b in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Star Block** (20-1/2" square unfinished).



Star Block - Make 1

8. Refer to Triptych Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of **Star Block**, panels, and borders.

9. Sew **Fabric B** 2" x 20-1/2" borders to right and left sides of **Star Block**. Add **Fabric B** 2" x 23-1/2" border to bottom of block. Star Section measures 22" x 23-1/2" (unfinished).

10. Stitch **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x 24" borders to right and left sides of the **Fabric A** panel with barn. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/2" x 18" **Fabric C** strip to top of panel. *Trim top and sides of bordered panel so it measures 16-1/2" x 25" (unfinished).*

11. Sew **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 25" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" border to top of bordered panel.

12. Sew **Fabric G** 2" x 27" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric G** 2" x 23-1/2" border to top of bordered panel to complete Panel Section (23-1/2" x 28-1/2" unfinished).

13. Sew Panel Section and Star Section together. The Center Panel of Triptych measures approximately 23-1/2" x 50" (unfinished).

14. Stitch a **Fabric C** 1-1/4" x 24" border to right side of **Fabric A** panel with cow. Trim strip ends even. Add a **Fabric C** 1-1/4" x 14-3/4" border to top of panel. Trim strip ends even. Sew a **Fabric G** 2" x 24-3/4" border to left side of panel. Trim strip ends even. Stitch a **Fabric G** 2" x 16-1/4" border to bottom of panel. Trim strip ends even. The Left Panel of Triptych measures approximately 15-3/4" x 25-3/4" (unfinished).

15. In the same manner, make Right Panel of Triptych with **Fabric A** panel with horse. Add borders in the same order, with first border added to left of panel then working around panel clockwise.

16. Cut a 31" x 42" strip **Fabric B** backing. Cut in half to create (2) 21" x 31" backings for the Right and Left Panels. Make backing (**Fabric B**) for Center Panel approximately 6" larger than the top.

17. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!


Stripe and egg prints indicate orientation of directional prints.

Arrows, stripe, and egg print indicate orientation of directional prints.




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3. Cut the following for Banner:

Refer to thumbnails on pattern cover for Fabrics A-F used in this design.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strip, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (1) 9-1/2" x 25-1/2" farm stripe border with word stripe on top

Fabric B - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 27-1/2" borders. Cut remaining strips lengthwise into (2) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" borders

Fabric C - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (13) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally only as shown for 26 triangles 

Fabric D - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (13) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally only as shown for 26 triangles] and (4) 3-1/2" squares 

Fabric E - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

4. Piecing Order for Banner:

1. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics C** and **D** 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 26 Triangle Units (3-1/2" square unfinished).



2. Refer to Banner Layout for arrangement and placement of **Fabric A** stripe, Triangle Units, borders, and **Fabric D** squares.

3. Sew **Fabric B** 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" borders to short ends of **Fabric A** stripe. Add **Fabric B** 2" x 27-1/2" borders to long sides of **Fabric A** stripe for banner center (12-1/2" x 27-1/2" unfinished).

4. Arrange 4 Triangle Units on short ends of banner center as shown. Stitch into vertical rows (3-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished). Sew to ends of banner.

5. Arrange 9 Triangle Units and 2 **Fabric D** 3-1/2" squares in rows above and below banner center. Stitch into rows (3-1/2" x 33-1/2" unfinished). Sew to long edges of banner center.

6. The banner measures approximately 18-1/2" x 33-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric F**) approximately 5" larger than the top.

7. Layer and baste banner top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric E**) and enjoy!!
