Be sure to read the entire pattern before you begin. Quilt layout is on point, measure quilt center dimensions before cutting border pieces.



Subcut (120) 1½" x 2½" rectangles. (9) 3½" x WOF strips. Subcut (240) 1½" x 3½" rectangles.</p> <p>SASHING RECTANGLES: (4) 7½" x WOF strips. Subcut (84) 1½" x 7½" rectangles.</p> <p>SASHING STRIPS: (2) 1½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1½" x 9½" strips and (2) 1½" x 25½" strips. (2) 1½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1½" x 41½" strips. (3) 1½" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 1½" x 57½" strips. (4) 1½" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 1½" x 73½" strips. (5) 1½" x WOF strips. Subcut (6) 11⅞" squares; cut squares diagonally twice to yield (24) side setting triangles (will use only 22). Corner: (1) 5⅞" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 5⅞" squares; cut squares diagonally once to yield (4) corner setting triangles.</p>

C		2016Q-1 Stone	1/8	<p>PIECED BLOCK A (2): (1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 4" squares. <i>Designer's Note: use caution when cutting; 1/8yd will only leave 1/2" of excess lengthwise.</i></p>

E		2018Q-3 Yellow	1/4	PIECED BLOCK A (4): (2) 4" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 4" squares. <i>Designer's Note: use caution when cutting; 1/4yd will only leave 1" of excess lengthwise.</i>
F		2019Q-4 Red	7/8	BLOCK B (30): (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (30) 1 1/2" squares. (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (120) 2 1/2" squares.
G		2020Q-5 Ember INCLUDES BINDING	1	PIECED BLOCK A (6): (3) 4" x WOF strips. Subcut (24) 4" squares. BINDING: (9) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips together to form a continuous binding strip.


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Constructing Block A

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" **A** square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) 4" **H** square. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with another 2" **A** square at the diagonally opposite corner of the same **H** square. Unit measures 4" x 4" raw edge to raw edge. Make a total of (4) units.



2. Arrange and sew units to complete (1) block. Block should measure $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge.



3. Make a total number of blocks for the following prints:

[Note: (1) **Fabric H** Block made in Step 2].

(1) Block: **B**

(2) Blocks: **C, I**

(3) Blocks: **D, M**

(4) Blocks: **E, L**


(5) Blocks: **J, K**

(6) Blocks: **G**

(7) Blocks: **H**

Constructing Block B

4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **F** square. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with another $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** square at the diagonally opposite corner of the same **F** square. Unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge.




5. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** rectangle to the left of previously sewn unit, followed by (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** rectangle to the top. Unit measures $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge. Make a total of (2) units, and (2) mirror-imaged units.





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
5a. Sew (1) unit and (1) mirror-imaged unit to the opposite long sides of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** rectangle to make a row unit. Make (2) row units.



5b. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}''$ **F** square to make a row unit.



6. Sew together row units to complete (1) Block B. Make a total of (30) Block B's. Block should measure $7\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ raw edge to raw edge.



Quilt Center Assembly

7. Diagonal pieced row. Refer to quilt image for block placement, arrange and sew together pieced blocks, and $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ sashing rectangles, side setting triangles and corner triangles to make a pieced row.

Pieced Row 1 starts from top left corner.

PR 1 & 12. (2) side setting triangles, (2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** sashing rectangles and (1) Block A.

PR 2 & 11. (2) side setting triangles, (4) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** sashing rectangles, (2) Block A and (1) Block B.

PR 3 & 10. (2) side setting triangles, (6) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** sashing rectangles, (3) Block A and (2) Block B.

PR 4 & 9. (2) side setting triangles, (8) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** sashing rectangles, (4) Block A and (3) Block B.

PR 5 & 8. (2) side setting triangles, (10) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** sashing rectangles, (5) Block A and (4) Block B.

PR 6 & 7. (1) side setting triangle, (1) corner setting triangle, (12) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** sashing rectangles, (6) Block A and (5) Block B.

8. Sew together pieced rows and sashing strips refer to layout diagram on Page 5 for proper placement.


Add (2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** sashing rectangles to the top left, and bottom right, followed by (2) corner setting triangle to complete quilt center.

Quilt center should measure approximately $68\frac{1}{4}'' \times 79\frac{3}{4}''$ raw edge to raw edge.










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Quilt Top Assembly

9. Inner border. Sew (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $79\frac{3}{4}$ " **A** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $74\frac{1}{4}$ " **A** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
10. Outer border. Sew (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $85\frac{3}{4}$ " **L** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $80\frac{1}{4}$ " **L** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Finishing

11. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich.
12. Baste and quilt as desired.
13. Attach **Fabric G** binding to complete quilt.
