


- a. Quilt center
- (1) 36 1/2" x 36 1/2" square, centering design.

#### Constructing inner border #5 pieced block

1. Flying geese unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric 1 square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" background rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with (1) 2 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric 2 square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle to make (1) flying geese unit.



Make (1) flying geese unit for the following Fabric 1 / Fabric 2 fabric combinations:



2. Refer to block diagram below, and noting the fabric placement, sew (2) step 1 flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " print square to make a row unit.




Sew (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares to the opposite sides of (1) step 1 flying geese unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.



3. Sew together step 2 row units to complete (1) pieced block. Sew (2) 1 ½" x 8 ½" background rectangles to the opposite sides of star unit, followed by (2) 1 ½" x 10 ½" background rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of star unit to complete (1) pieced block.




4. Make a total of (4) pieced blocks for each of the following fabric print:




#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

- 1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 1 ¾" x 36 ½" background strips to the opposite sides of Fabric U quilt center, followed by (2) 1 ¾" x 39" background strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
- 2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 1 ¼" x 39" Fabric J strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1 ¼" x 40 ½" Fabric J strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.




3. Inner border #3. Arrange and sew together (20) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares of assorted prints to make a column unit. Make (2) column units, and sew units along the long sides to make a pieced column. Make a total of (2) pieced columns, and sew to the left and right sides of quilt center.

Arrange and sew together (24) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares of assorted prints to make a row unit. Make (2) row units, and sew units along the long sides to make a pieced row. Make a total of (2) pieced rows, and sew to the top and bottom of quilt center.




4. Inner border #4. Sew (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric J strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric J strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.




5. Inner border #5. Arrange and sew (5) pieced blocks to make a pieced column. Make (2) pieced columns and sew to the opposite sides of quilt center.

Arrange and sew (7) pieced blocks to make a pieced row. Make (2) pieced rows and sew to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.



6. Outer border. Sew (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 76  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



## Finishing

- 1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
- 2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to complete the quilt.
