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DREAMER'S VIEW QUILT PATTERN


Materials and Cutting—*Fawned of You* collection (option 1)

Fabric		Yardage	Cutting
	Jax Stella-1560 Marshmallow	3 yards	Cut: 3 A1 strips, $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric (WOF). 8 strips, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF, for binding. 44 A2 strips, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF.
	Moonscape Stella-1150 Marlin	$1\frac{1}{8}$ yards	Cut: 2 strips, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Sub-cut 20 B squares, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". 18 B strips, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF.

	Avocado Toast Stella-DJL1898 Multi		
	Edible Flowers Stella-DJL1903 Multi	$\frac{5}{8}$ yards <i>each</i>	From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: 3 C strips, $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Group matching strips together.

Note: All seam allowances are $1\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise specified. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

Make the Blocks


- Arrange three **A1** strips and two **B** strips as shown. Sew the strips together along adjacent long edges to make a single strip set. Press. Cut 24 segments, each $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide.



Make 1 strip set.
Cut 24 segments, each $1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

- Arrange three matching **C** strips and two **A2** strips as shown. Sew the strips together along adjacent long edges to

make a single strip set. Press. Cut six $5\frac{1}{2}$ -wide segments from the strip set. Group the matching segments together.



Make 1 strip set.
Cut 6 segments, each $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

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

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③ Repeat step 2 with the remaining **C** strips, making a total of six sets of six matching 5½"-wide segments.


④ Select two 1½"-wide segments from step 1, and three matching 5½"-wide segments from steps 2–3. Arrange the segments as shown. Sew the segments together along adjacent edges, matching seam lines. Press. Make a total of twelve blocks.



Make 12 blocks.

Make the Sashings

① Sew an **A2** strip on either side of a **B** strip. Press. Make 16 strip sets. Cut 31 sashing strips, each 17½"-wide.



Make 16 strip sets.
Cut 31 segments, each 17½" wide.

Assemble the Quilt

① Referring to the quilt photo for block placement, arrange the blocks in four rows of three blocks each. Place a sashing strip between each block and at the start and end of each row.

② Join the sashing strips and blocks in each row together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances in one direction.

③ Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, alternate four **B** squares with three sashing strips in a single row. Sew the strips and squares together along adjacent edges. Press the seam


allowances in one direction, opposite the pressing direction used in the block rows. Make 5 sashing rows.

④ Place a sashing row between each block row, and at the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew the rows and sashing rows together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances in one direction.

Finishing

① Using a ½" seam allowance, join the two large backing rectangles along one long edge and press to complete the quilt backing.

② Layer the quilt backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch a scant ¼" from the edge around the perimeter of the quilt. Trim the excess backing and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.
