 Soho Solids White	2 yards	<p>Cut:</p> <p>1 strip, 12¹/₂" × WOF. Sub-cut 12 A7 block sashing, 1¹/₂" × 12¹/₂", and 12 A8 row sashing, 1¹/₂" × 8¹/₂".</p> <p>4 strips, 8¹/₂" × WOF. Sub-cut 64 A3 rectangles, 2¹/₂" × 8¹/₂".</p> <p>5 strips, 2" × WOF. Sub-cut 2 top/bottom Border 1 strips, 2" × 38¹/₂". Sew the remaining strips end to end, press seam allowances open, and cut two side Border 1 strips, 2" × 51¹/₂".</p> <p>3 strips, 2" × width of fabric (WOF). Sub-cut 48 A1 squares, 2" × 2".</p> <p>1 strip, 1¹/₂" × WOF. Sub-cut 16 A2 squares, 1¹/₂" × 1¹/₂".</p>

 Rainbows Stella-1797 White	1/4 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>5 strips, 1¹/₄" × WOF. Sub-cut 2 top/bottom Border 2 strips, 1¹/₄" × 40". Sew the remaining strips together end to end, press seam allowances open. Sub-cut 2 side Border 2 strips, 1¹/₄" × 54¹/₂".</p>
 Moonscape Stella-1150 Beige	1/8 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>1 strip, 1¹/₂" × WOF. Sub-cut 16 D rectangles, 1¹/₂" × 2".</p>
 Peace Out Stella-1794 Orient	3 yards	Remove selvages and cut yardage into two equal lengths for backing.



Note: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise specified. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

Make the Popsicle Blocks

1 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each **B1** square. Place one marked **B1** square right sides together on the corner of one **A1** square, matching two outer edges. Sew along the marked line, then trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the triangle open. Make 16 **A1/B1** units.




2 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each **A2** square. Place one marked **A2** square right sides together on the corner of one **B2** square, matching two outer edges. Sew along the marked line, then trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the triangle open. Make 16 **A2/B2** units.



3 Sew each **A1/B1** unit to a matching **A2/B2** unit as shown. Press.



4 Sew one short edge of a matching **B3** rectangle to the lower edge of the joined step 3 units. Press.




5 Sew one **A1** square to either side of a **D** rectangle. Make 16 units. Press.




6 Sew one step 5 unit to the bottom of each step 4 unit to complete each popsicle unit. Press.



7 Sew one **A3** rectangle to either side of each popsicle unit. Press. Sew one **A3** rectangle to the top, and another to the bottom of each popsicle unit. Press.



8 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each **C** square. Noting orientations, place one marked **C** square right sides together each corner of one popsicle unit, matching two outer edges. Sew along the marked line, then trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the triangles open to complete the block. Make 16 Popsicle Blocks.

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Assemble the Quilt

1 Referring to the quilt photo for block placement, arrange the Popsicle Blocks in four rows of four blocks each. Place an **A7** block sashing between the blocks in each row. Sew the blocks and block sashings together along adjacent edges. Press.

2 Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, arrange four **A8** row sashings in a single row. Place one **B1** square between each row sashing. Sew the sashings and squares together along adjacent edges. Press. Make three sashing rows.

3 Place a sashing row between each block row. Matching seam lines, sew the block and sashing rows together along adjacent edges. Press the seams in one direction to complete the quilt center.


4 Sew one side Border 1 to either side of the quilt center. Press. Sew one top/bottom Border 1 to the top, and the other to the bottom of the quilt center. Press.

5 Repeat step 4 to add Borders 2, 3, and 4 in order to the quilt center. Press.

Finishing

1 Using a 1/2" seam allowance, join the two large backing rectangles along one long edge. Press. Join the rectangles to the remaining backing yardage along one long edge to complete the quilt backing. Press.

2 Layer the quilt backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch a scant 1/4" from the edge around the perimeter of the quilt. Trim the excess backing and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.
