

## Fabric Requirements

3<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yards Block-C8400 White

One CPSTRIP40-CM Sapphire 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip set  
(forty 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × width-of-fabric [WOF] strips)

4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yards Fleur-CM1005 Blue (backing)

2/3 yard Shimmer Cornflower (binding)

79" × 79" batting

## Cutting

### From Block-C8400 White:

- Cut sixteen 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips. Sub-cut (252) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares.
- Cut one 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strip. Sub-cut twenty-six 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- Cut two 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-six 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips from one strip; sub-cut ten 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" and ten 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips from the other strip.
- Cut one 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strip. Sub-cut twenty-six 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- Cut two 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-six 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips from one strip; sub-cut ten 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" and ten 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips from the other strip.
- Cut two 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips. Sub-cut eight 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" sashing strips.
- Cut two 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips. Sub-cut fifty-two 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" sashing strips.
- Cut seven 3" × WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and cut two 3" × 65<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips and two 3" × 70<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips for outer borders.

If you prefer a more scrappy look, cut the cornerstones from assorted blue leftovers.

### From 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Sapphire strips:

Note: You will have some leftover strips.

- Select thirty-six strips of your choice. Sub-cut from each strip, one 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square, one 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangle, one 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip, one 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip, one 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip and one 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip. Keep the cut strips together by color as each set makes one block.
- From one strip, sub-cut twenty-five 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" cornerstone squares.

### From Shimmer Cornflower:

- Cut eight 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips for binding.

## Block Construction

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right sides together. Note that each block uses a single Sapphire blue fabric.

1. Sew together one 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C8400 White square and one 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" blue square (*figure 1*).


2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (216) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C8400 White squares. Place a marked square on the corner of the 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" blue rectangle as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the sewn line. Open and press to reveal the corner triangle (*figure 2*).


3. Sew the step 1 unit to the top of the step 2 unit. Following Figure 3, place a marked square on the top left corner of the sewn unit. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the sewn line. Open and press to reveal the corner triangle.


4. Sew a  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White strip to the left of the step 3 unit, followed by a  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White strip to the bottom (*figure 4*).


5. Following Figure 5, place a marked square on the left corner of the  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$  blue strip. Sew on the drawn line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}''$  from the sewn line. Open and press to reveal the corner triangle. Repeat with another  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White square on the right end of the  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$  blue strip.


6. Following Figure 6, sew the  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$  blue strip to the left of the step 4 unit and the  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$  blue strip to the bottom.


7. Sew a  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White strip to the left of step 6 unit, followed by a  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White strip to the bottom (*figure 7*).


8. Referring back to Figure 5, add a marked  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White square to the left corner of a  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$  blue strip and to the right corner of a  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$  blue strip. Sew the  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$  strip to the left side of the step 7 unit and the  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$  strip to the bottom (*figure 8*).

9. Repeat steps 1-8 to make a total of thirty-six assorted blue blocks.

## Quilt Top Assembly

10. Following the quilt image for orientation, lay out six rows of six blocks each. Add a  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White sashing strip between each pieced block. Sew together the blocks and sashing in each row and number the rows for easier assembly.
11. To make the sashing rows, alternately sew together six  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White strips and five  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  blue squares. Make a total of five horizontal sashing rows.
12. Sew the block rows together in order alternately with a sashing row between to complete the quilt top center.
13. Sew a  $3'' \times 65\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White strip to each side of the quilt center followed by a  $3'' \times 70\frac{1}{2}''$  C8400 White strip to the top and another to the bottom.

## Finishing

14. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
15. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
16. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.

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
