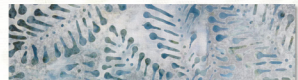

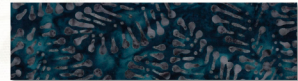

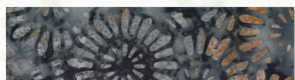

Safe Harbor


Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:


If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

PLEASE NOTE:


Cut all 4-7/8" and 2-7/8" squares in half diagonally for the  number of triangles indicated in [].


Fabric A - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 4-7/8" squares  [16]

Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, (4) 4-1/2" squares, and (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces


Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-7/8" squares  [16]

Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (80) 2-1/2" squares


Fabric B - Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 4-1/2" squares and (2) 2-7/8" squares  [4]

Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (14) 2-7/8" squares  [28]


Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (28) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 4-7/8" squares  [8] and (8) 2-1/2" squares


Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (12) 2-7/8" squares  [24]

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 4-7/8" squares  [4]


Cut (7) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" borders

Fabric E - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 4-7/8" squares  [4] and (4) 4-1/2" squares


Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares


Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric F - Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (12) 2-7/8" squares  [24]


Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (6) 2-7/8" squares  [12]


Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (64) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (3) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (42) 2-7/8" squares  [84]


Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (88) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (16) 2-7/8" squares  [32] and (8) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric J - Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (28) 2-7/8" squares  [56]


Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (44) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric K - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (6) 4-7/8" squares  [12] and (2) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles and (2) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric L - Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric M - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 4-7/8" squares  [4]

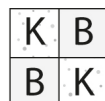
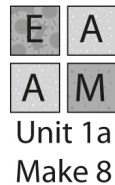

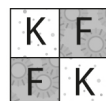

2. Piecing Order:

1. Arrange 2 **Fabric A** and 1 each **Fabrics E** and **M** 2-1/2" squares in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 1a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 1b-1i listed with fabrics indicated.



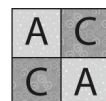

2. Sew 1 each **Fabrics K** and **M** 4-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 4 Unit 2a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 2b-2d listed with fabrics indicated.

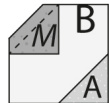

4. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 12 **Fabric A**, 4 **Fabric B**, 16 **Fabric C**, 16 **Fabric H**, 12 **Fabric J**, 4 **Fabric M** 2-1/2" squares.



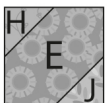
Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

5. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics A** and **M** marked 2-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric B** 4-1/2" square as shown.

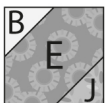

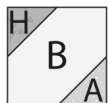
Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 4 Unit 4a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 4b-4d listed with fabrics indicated.

6. Using the same flip and sew technique in Step 5, sew 2 **Fabric C** 2-1/2" marked squares to **Fabrics E** and **D** corners of a Unit 2d to create triangle corners. Make a total of 4 Unit 5 (4-1/2" square unfinished).

7. Using the same flip and sew technique in Step 5, sew 1 **Fabric C** 2-1/2" marked square to corner of a **Fabric A** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece as shown to make 4 each Units 6a and 6b (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" square unfinished).

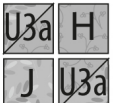

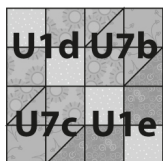
10. Arrange 2 Unit 1a, 1 Unit 4a, and 1 **Fabric C** 4-1/2" square in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 1 (8-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Blocks 2a-5 listed with fabrics and units indicated.



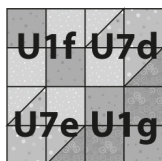

11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, units, squares, rectangles, and borders.

12. Arrange blocks in 8 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (48-1/2" x 64-1/2" unfinished).

13. Arrange 2 each Units 1i, 2b, and 2c; 2 **Fabric K** 4-1/2" squares; 2 **Fabric A** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles; and 2 **Fabric K** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles in vertical rows on right and left sides of quilt center. Stitch into vertical borders (4-1/2" x 64-1/2" unfinished). Stitch borders to right and left sides of quilt center.

14. Arrange 2 each Units 1i, 2a, 2b, and 2c; 2 **Fabric A** 4-1/2" squares; and 2 **Fabric K** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles in horizontal rows above and below the quilt center. Stitch into horizontal borders (4-1/2" x 56-1/2" unfinished). Stitch borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

15. Sew **Fabric D** 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric D** 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

16. The quilt measures approximately 62-1/2" x 78-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric N**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

17. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric E**) and enjoy!!
